


The Big "G"

G = gallon (gal)
Q = quart (qt)
P = pint (pt)
C = cup (c)
1 cup = 8 ounces (oz)



Area and Perimeter Equations and Definitions

- Area
 - The space on the inside
 - Length X width
- Perimeter
 - The area around the outside of the object
 - Think the "rim" in perimeter
 - Add up all the sides
 - $L+W+L+W$
 - $(L+W) \times 2$

Conversions- Need to be memorized for the test!!

Metric Conversion

King	Henry	Died	Unusually 	Drinking	Chocolate	Milk 
Kilo  $10 \times 10 \times 10 \times$ LARGER than a unit $1 \text{ kilo} = 1,000 \text{ units}$	Hecto $10 \times 10 \times$ LARGER than a unit $1 \text{ hecto} = 100 \text{ units}$	Deca $10 \times$ LARGER than a unit $1 \text{ deca} = 10 \text{ units}$	* Unit * Meter <i>(length)</i> Liter <i>(liquid volume)</i> Gram <i>(mass/weight)</i> 1 unit	Deci $10 \times$ SMALLER than a unit $10 \text{ deci} = 1 \text{ unit}$	Centi $10 \times 10 \times$ SMALLER than a unit $100 \text{ centi} = 1 \text{ unit}$	Milli $10 \times 10 \times 10 \times$ SMALLER than a unit $1,000 \text{ milli} = 1 \text{ unit}$
km = kilometer KL = kiloliter kg = kilogram	hm = hectometer hL = hectoliter hg = hectogram	dam = decameter dal = decaliter dag = decagram	m = meter L = liter g = gram	dm = decimeter dL = deciliter dg = décigram	cm = centimeter cL = centiliter cg = centigram	mm = millimeter mL = milliliter mg = milligram
Example: 5 kilo	50 hecto	500 deca	5,000 units	50,000 deci	500,000 centi	5,000,000 milli

Count how many spots you are jumping to the right and add that many zeroes for conversions!

Units of time

1 hour = 60 minutes	1 minute = 60 seconds
1 day = 24 hours	1 week = 7 days
1 year = 365 days	1 year = 52 weeks
1 year = 12 months	1 leap year = 366 days

Customary Units of Length

1 foot = 12 inches	1 yard = 3 feet
1 mile = 5,280 feet	1 mile = 1,760 yards

Customary Units of Weight

1 pound = 16 ounces	1 ton = 2,000 pounds
---------------------	----------------------

Customary Units of Liquid Volume

1 cup = 8 ounces	1 quart = 4 cups
1 pint = 2 cups	1 gallon = 4 quarts
